To: Worshipful Masters, Wardens, Brethren and All Owing Allegiance to the MOST
WORSHIPFUL PRINCE HALL GRAND LODGE of Virginia, F. & A.M., INC.

SUBJECT: FOUNDER'S DAY

Know ye by these presents; by virtue of the authority vested in the office of the Most Worshipful Grand Master, I, Donald S. Wilson, Grand Master of Prince Hall Masons in the Jurisdiction of Virginia, do hereby decree that **Founder's Day** will be celebrated in the Jurisdiction of Virginia on May 21, 2023, at First Baptist Church, Petersburg, Virginia.

All elected, appointed Grand Lodge officers and Most Worshipful Past Grand Masters shall wear the regalia of their position. Master Masons or Order of Eastern Stars, Masonic Lodge three principal officers and past masters may wear regalia of their position.
